The Crisis Control gift of the month for March is pancake mix and syrup. The kids' gift of the month is granola bars.

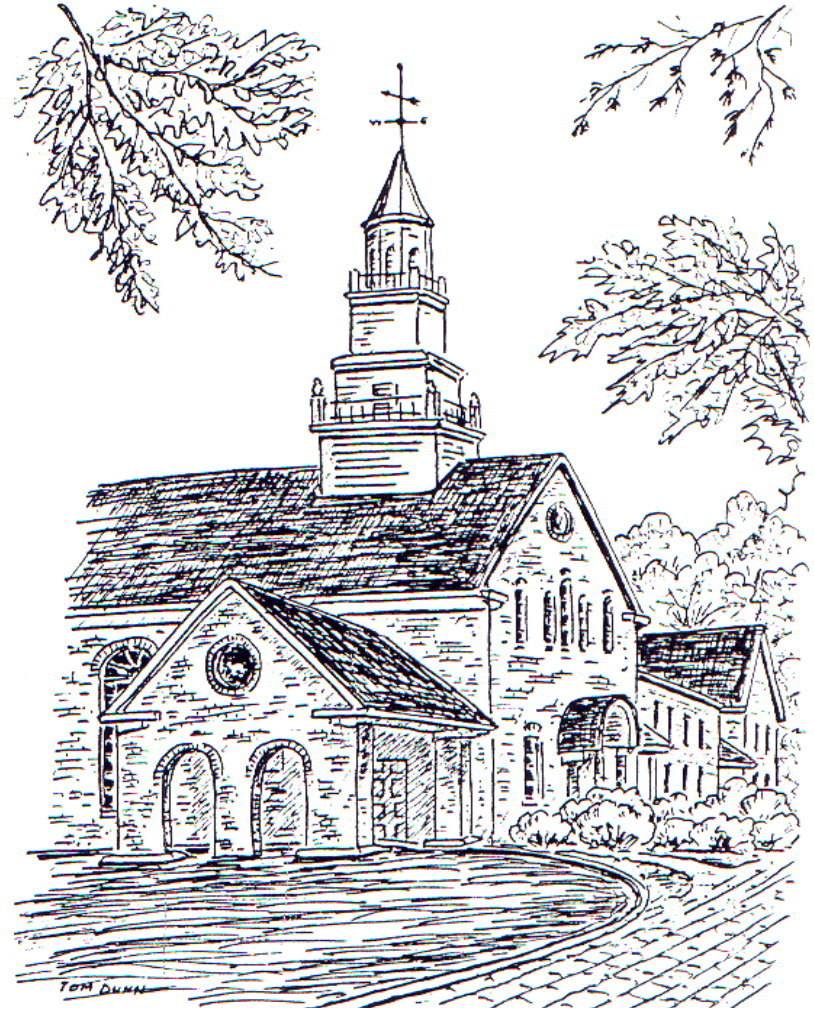
